Family CARE Program at Cancer CAREpoint

After receiving exceptional reviews following the inaugural Family CARE program in November, Cancer CAREpoint is excited to announce another 4 week series from February 23 - March 15, 2016 at the Cancer CAREpoint resource center. This program is designed to facilitate healthy communication within families when a parent is diagnosed with cancer. Our hope is to ensure that every child whose parent is diagnosed with cancer is given the early tools and emotional support to cope.

Parents and children meet together for a meal at the onset of the 1.5 hour session. Then, we split up the parents and children in separate groups by age (5-8, 9-12, teens), facilitated by Cancer CAREpoint social workers and staff. Parents have the opportunity to learn tools to communicate with their children in a supportive environment. Children feel comfortable talking about cancer utilizing expressive art and play exercises.

HAMED SAJJADI, M.D.

San Jose Ear and Sinus Medical Center



San Jose Ear and Sinus Medical Center (SJEAS) was founded by Dr. Hamed Sajjadi and Mrs. Azar Sajjadi in January 2003 at its current location of 2577 Samaritan Drive, Suite 845, San Jose, California.

Dr. Sajjadi specializes in disorders of the ear, hearing, balance, skull base tumors and paranasal sinuses. He is also a part-time clinical faculty member at Stanford University, and is assisted by two specialized Otolaryngology Physician

Assistants, Sherry Derakhshandeh and Alejandra Perez, two full-time Audiologists, a Hearing Aid Specialist, and three dedicated Medial Assistants.

Special services include Digital Hearing aids, cochlear implants for the profoundly deaf, hearing aid implants, minimally invasive balloon Sinuplasty, Eustachian tube balloon dilation, and skull base tumor resections.

Dr. Sajjadi has been one of the pioneers in the country developing the parameters and technique for performing Transnasal Endoscopic Eustachian tube balloon dilation since 2011. This is a minimally invasive and very new technique that helps reduce or alleviate chronic recurrent ear pressure and pain on airplane flights and mountain driving. It has reduced the need to do ear tube surgery in a large number of patients.
